

TOUR BASICS



- Greater Cleveland Aquarium education programs are based on Ohio Learning Standards.
- All programs are guided by a member of the Aquarium staff.
- Unless otherwise noted, programs last 2 hours and include 1/2 hour for lunch.
- 1 teacher/chaperone is required and admitted free for every 10 students.
- For classes with special needs, 1 teacher/chaperone is required and admitted free for every 5 students.
- Some programs have age and class size restrictions.
- Group rates for additional chaperones are only available when included in the group payment transaction. Rates for individuals paying separately from group may differ.
