

We are regularly consulting with our industry and community partners and following information coming from public health officials, the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and World Health Organization (WHO) closely. We have expanded our already robust cleaning protocols, placed proper handwashing reminders in the restrooms and created additional hand sanitizer stations.

We remind guests and team members to follow the recommended preventive measures:

- Wash your hands frequently for at least 20 seconds each time with soap and water.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue that is then thrown away.
- Stay home when you are unwell.
